- Candidates without a qualification in the related fields or working experience in the relevant fields must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the programme and meet the minimum CGPA based on (a) to (b); or
- A diploma from any institutions of higher learning recognised by the University Senate with at least ten (10) years of relevant work experiences, 35 years or older and passes APEL assessment (level 7).
