- A Bachelor's degree in the field or related fields from Universiti Utara Malaysia or any other institutions of higher learning recognised by the University Senate with a CGPA of 2.00 to 2.49 can be accepted subject to minimum five (5) years working experience in relevant field and an interview by the Postgraduate Committee; or any other equivalent qualifications recognized by the University Senate; and
- fulfil the English Language requirement as set by the University Senate.
